Squishy Circuits: What are electric circuits? Use meters and an oscilloscope to study electric current flow, then make circuits to light LEDs, run motors and play sound!

Combustion and Pyrotechnics: Investigate thermochemistry through experiments with chemical combinations and physical forces that tend to flare, fizzle, spark, and even explode!

Physics of Catapults: Build a working replica of this ancient weapon! Consider the physics behind the action and incorporate your own personal touch!
